

7-Day Mallorca Itinerary

Cliffside Villages to Beach Club Sunsets

Mallorca is the Balearic's most complete island trip — Gothic cathedral spires and tapas bars in Palma, a vintage train into the Tramuntana mountains, and turquoise coves along the north coast, all within an hour's drive of each other. The island is having a big moment this August: Europe's total solar eclipse sweeps directly over Mallorca on August 12, 2026, and beach clubs from Palma to Alcúdia are already booking out around it. This loop hits the classics — old town, mountains, coast — with enough beach-club time built in to make the most of summer's longest days.

Day 1

Arrive in Palma, Settle into the Old Town

Land at Palma de Mallorca Airport (PMI) and head straight into the old town — cobblestone lanes, tapas bars, and the cathedral's silhouette over the harbor make for an easy first evening.

CAR

Private Transfer — Palma Airport (PMI) to Palma Old Town

~25 minutes · From \$35–50 USD one-way per vehicle (up to 4 people)

A private car is the simplest way in after a flight — Hotel Cort sits deep in the pedestrian old town, a short walk from where a taxi can actually drop you.

STAY

Overnight — Hotel Cort

From \$230–280 USD / night, for 2 people

A boutique hotel right on Plaça de Cort, in the heart of Palma's old town and a five-minute walk from the cathedral — rooftop pool included.

FOOD

Dinner in Palma Old Town

Est. \$30–50 USD / person

On your own — the streets around Plaça de la Llotja and Carrer de Sant Joan are packed with tapas bars and seafood restaurants; no reservation needed for a casual first night.

Day 2**Palma Cathedral & Old Town**

Palma's Gothic cathedral anchors a full day of wandering — save the afternoon for Bellver Castle's hilltop views over the bay.

SIGHT**Palma Cathedral (La Seu) Skip-the-Line Ticket****~1 hour · From \$14 USD / person**

One of Europe's tallest Gothic cathedrals, with a vast rose window and a Gaudí-redesigned interior. Buy a timed ticket online to skip the entrance queue, especially in August.

SIGHT**Bellver Castle****~1.5 hours · \$4.50 USD / person admission**

A rare circular hilltop castle a short taxi or bus ride from downtown, with sweeping views over Palma Bay — a good spot to catch the breeze on a hot August afternoon.

STAY**Overnight — Hotel Cort****From \$230–280 USD / night, for 2 people**

Second night at the same hotel — no need to pack up.

Day 3**Beach Club Day at Nikki Beach Mallorca**

Mallorca's beach-club scene is having a moment this summer — trade the old town for a day of white daybeds and DJ sets on the west coast.

CAR**Transfer — Palma to Nikki Beach Mallorca (Magaluf)****~20–25 minutes · Taxi from \$30–40 USD each way**

A quick taxi ride west along the coast road; taxis queue outside most Palma hotels, or your hotel concierge can book one for a set time.

SIGHT**Nikki Beach Mallorca — Sunbed Reservation****Full day · From \$38 USD / person (high-season sunbed), food & drink extra**

One of Mallorca's best-known beach clubs, with white daybeds steps from the water and a DJ running from midday. Book sunbeds online in advance — August weekends sell out.

STAY Overnight — Hotel Cort

From \$230–280 USD / night, for 2 people

Third and final night in Palma before heading for the mountains.

Day 4 Palma to Sóller by Vintage Train

One of Mallorca's classic rides — a century-old wooden train climbs through orange groves and mountain tunnels into the Tramuntana, ending at the sea in Sóller.

SIGHT Ferrocarril de Sóller — Palma to Sóller

~1 hour · Round-trip about \$35 USD / person

Built in 1912, the vintage wooden train winds through 13 tunnels and pine forest before dropping into the Sóller valley — reserve a same-day return or continue on the connecting tram to the port.

SIGHT Port de Sóller — Tram Ride & Waterfront

~10 minutes each way · \$10 USD / person one-way

A vintage open-sided tram rattles down through town to the horseshoe-shaped harbor — worth the ride for the views alone, then stay for a swim or a walk along the promenade.

STAY Overnight — Gran Hotel Sóller

From \$300–350 USD / night, for 2 people

A restored 19th-century mansion turned five-star hotel in the middle of Sóller's old town, with a rooftop pool and views up into the mountains.

Day 5 Tramuntana Villages — Valldemossa & Deià

The road between Sóller and Valldemossa is one of the most scenic drives on the island — terraced hillsides, stone villages, and views down to the Mediterranean at every turn.

TOUR

Guided Tour — Valldemossa & Deià Villages

~5 hours · From \$100 USD / person

A small-group tour through two of the Tramuntana’s postcard villages — Valldemossa’s Royal Carthusian Monastery, where Chopin spent a winter, and Deià’s artist-colony lanes, with a stop at a coastal mirador.
