

Amber Fort, City Palace, Hawa Mahal & Jantar Mantar — Composite Ticket

2-day validity · About \$18 USD / person

One ticket covers admission to five of Jaipur's major monuments, including the hilltop Amber Fort with its Sheesh Mahal mirror hall and the 18th-century Jantar Mantar observatory. Buy it at the first site you visit.

Private Full-Day Sightseeing by Car — Amber Fort, Hawa Mahal & City Palace

~7–8 hours · About \$40 USD / person

An air-conditioned car and English-speaking driver-guide for the day, work 77.5 l q80 1 1d About \$40 USD / person

Evening — Clock Tower & Sardar Market

~1.5 hours, self-guided · Free

On your own — a short walk from the haveli into Jodhpur's spice, textile and silverware stalls around the 1912 clock tower, busiest and coolest after the day's heat breaks.

Day 4

Mehrangarh Fort & the Blue City

Jodhpur's single unmissable sight in the morning, then the royal family's Art Deco palace-turned-museum in the afternoon.

Mehrangarh Fort & Blue City Private Guided Tour

~5 hours · About \$45 USD / person

A guide walks you through Mehrangarh's courtyards and the mirrored Sheesh Mahal, then down into the blue-painted lanes below the ramparts, finishing at Jaswant Thada, the white marble royal cenotaph.

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Umaid Bhawan Palace Museum

~1 hour · About \$4 USD / person

One of the world's largest private residences, completed in 1943 — part is still a Taj hotel and part is the current royal family's home, but the museum wing of vintage cars and Art Deco interiors is open to visitors.

Dinner — Indique Restaurant & Bar, Pal Haveli

Est. \$15–25 USD / person

The haveli's own rooftop restaurant, with Mehrangarh Fort floodlit directly overhead after dark — no need to book elsewhere.

Day 5

Transfer to Udaipur via Kumbhalgarh & Ranakpur

The longest drive of the trip, broken up by two of Rajasthan's best stops along the way — a fort with a wall nearly as long as the Great Wall of China, and one of India's most intricately carved temples.

Private Transfer — Jodhpur to Udaipur via Ranakpur & Kumbhalgarh Fort

~8–10 hours incl. stops · About \$44 USD / person

A private car with stops at the 15th-century marble Ranakpur Jain Temple, famous for its 1,444 carved pillars, and Kumbhalgarh Fort, a UNESCO World Heritage hill fort ringed by a 36 km wall, before continuing on to Udaipur.

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Check-In — Jagat Niwas Palace

From \$74 USD / night, for 2 people

A 17th-century haveli-turned-hotel on Lal Ghat, right on Lake Pichola with the Jagdish Temple around the corner — ask for a lake-view room facing the water.

Day 6

City Palace & Sunset on Lake Pichola

Udaipur's two headline sights in one day — the largest royal palace complex in Rajasthan, then the lake it looks out over.

City Palace Udaipur

~2 hours · About \$14.50 USD / person

A sprawling complex of courtyards, museums and mirrored halls built up over nearly 400 years by successive Maharanas, with the best views of Lake Pichola and the Lake Palace from its upper terraces.

Lake Pichola Sunset Boat Ride

~1 hour · About \$8.50 USD / person

A covered boat departs from the Rameshlaj T* p0l20Fityp0l the(City Palac, circwlingpjase Ja M anir isl and and theTaje) Tj T* Lake Palacewa

Private Airport Transfer — Udaipur City to Maharana Pratap Airport (UDR)

~30 minutes · About \$20 USD for 2 people

The airport sits about 22 km southeast of the old city; the hotel can arrange a car directly, or book ahead through the same driver network used earlier in the trip.
