

Seven Coloured Earths by Day, Sega Drums by Night — A 6-Day Mauritius Itinerary

A 6-day I-Journey itinerary · Grand Baie · Chamarel · Le Morne · Belle Mare

DURATION 6 Days	BEST TIME TO GO May – December (dry, cooler season) warm and humid year-round; May–Dec brings lower humidity and less rain (Jan–Mar carries cyclone risk)	FROM \$1,890 USD / person for 2 people sharing mid-range beachfront hotels, tours & transfers; excludes international flights
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Six days around Mauritius's coastline — a north-shore lagoon base in Grand Baie, the rainbow-striped dunes of Chamarel and a rum-distillery lunch, a night under the shadow of Le Morne Brabant with a guided hike through Black River Gorges, and a finish on the east coast with a catamaran crossing to Ile aux Cerfs. Real resorts, real tour operators, and 2026 prices for every stop.

Day 1

Arrival & Grand Baie's Lagoon

Touch down on the island's north coast and settle into Grand Baie, Mauritius's liveliest lagoon town, with a first sunset over the water.

Private Transfer: SSR International Airport to Grand Baie

~1 hour, 30 miles · from \$50 USD, each way, for the car

A private air-conditioned transfer meets you at Sir Seewoosagur Ramgoolam International Airport (MRU) for the drive up the east side of the island to Grand Baie, passing sugarcane fields and the Moka mountain range along the way.

Check-In: Veranda Grand Baie Hotel & Spa

From \$145 USD / night, for 2 people

A 4-star boutique resort right on Grand Baie's public beach, with a spa, two pools and a short walk to the town's restaurants and boutiques — a relaxed base for your first two nights.

Sunset Beach Walk & Dinner at La Terrasse

~2 hours · dinner ~\$30–\$45 USD / person

Walk the curve of Grand Baie's public beach as the sun drops behind the bay, then head to La Terrasse on Route Royal for Creole and seafood plates on an open-air terrace overlooking the harbor.

Chamarel Seven Coloured Earths Geopark

~1.5 hours · entry ~\$7 USD / person

Volcanic ash has weathered into dunes of red, brown, violet, green, blue, purple and yellow that never erode into each other — walk the boardwalk loop, then continue a few hundred yards to the viewpoint over Chamarel Waterfall's 300-foot drop.

Rum Tasting & Lunch: Rhumerie de Chamarel

~2 hours · distillery tour & tasting ~\$15 USD, lunch ~\$25–\$40 USD / person

A working sugarcane distillery on a former colonial estate — tour the cane fields and stills, taste flights of white, spiced and vanilla rum, then stay for a Creole lunch on the estate's restaurant terrace.

Check-In: Dinarobin Beachcomber Golf Resort & Spa

From \$310 USD / night, for 2 people

A five-star resort on the calm lagoon side of the Le Morne peninsula, with the sheer basalt face of Le Morne Brabant — a UNESCO World Heritage site — rising directly behind the pools.

Day 4

Black River Gorges & Le Morne

A guided rainforest hike through the island's largest national park, then an afternoon on Le Morne's kite-surfing lagoon.

Guided Hike: Black River Gorges National Park

~4 hours incl. transport · from \$60–\$80 USD / person

A local guide leads a half-day trek through Mauritius's largest national park — native ebony forest, waterfall viewpoints and a chance at spotting the endangered Mauritius kestrel — before dropping back to the resort by early afternoon.

Afternoon at Leisure: Le Morne Lagoon

~3 hours · free (kitesurf lessons extra, from ~\$60 USD)

Le Morne's shallow, wind-swept lagoon is one of the world's best kitesurfing spots — spend the afternoon on the resort's beach, book a lesson with the on-site kite school, or simply watch the kites from the sand.

Farewell Sega Show & Dinner

~2 hours · often included with resort half-board, or ~\$40–\$60 USD / person

Many east-coast resorts host a weekly Sega night — Mauritius's Creole folk dance, driven by ravanne drums and swaying hips — paired with a beachfront barbecue buffet; ask the concierge for the schedule during your stay.

Private Transfer: Belle Mare to SSR International Airport

~1 hour, 30 miles · from \$50 USD, each way, for the car

A private transfer collects you from the resort for the drive back to the airport — build in extra time if your flight departs during afternoon rush hour around Port Louis.
